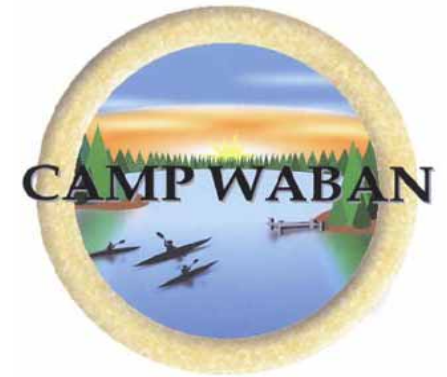

Camp Waban 2012

Camp Waban is located on a quiet forested corner of Bauneg Beg Lake, in Sanford, Maine.



Individuals, families, group homes, schools, and organizations serving people with disabilities are welcome to rent the facilities. All paths are paved, making the entire camp accessible to every visitor. A beach wheelchair is available for access across the sand to the waterfront.



The bathhouse which is adjacent to the waterfront is fully accessible with toilets, shower and changing areas.

The rustic cabins vary in capacity from 6 to 16 beds and have electricity, a refrigerator and bathrooms. Washers and dryers are available in most cabins.

Meals are included for half-week and weeklong campers. Staff will serve a hot breakfast and bag lunches. Dinner is unique - staff will prep the evening meal for campers to heat and eat at their leisure.

Menus will be provided prior to arrival.

Campers are responsible for their own transportation, bedding, and toiletries.

FAQs

Do campers need to be accompanied by staff/family members? Camp Waban requires all campers to attend with a staff or family member who is responsible for all personal care needs and daily programming. *Camper to staff ratio must be 3:1 or less.*

What activities are available at Camp Waban? Swimming, kayaking, paddle boating, pontoon boat rides, basketball, volleyball, wiffleball, movies, music, arts and crafts, a playground, nature walks on our handicapped accessible trail, bbq/grilling, fishing, camp fires, and local area attractions.

New this year:

TREE offerings available - participation fee required

Is there a set schedule for the activities offered? Campers and accompanying staff decide what activities they do and when to do them. Water activities are typically available between 9:00 am and 3:00 pm. Non-water activities are available at all times.

Are the cabins wheelchair accessible? All cabins have a barrier-free entrance. One cabin has a wheelchair accessible shower and two cabins have wheelchair accessible bathrooms. All campers can use the fully accessible bath house for toileting and showering needs at any time.

What should campers bring? Campers are responsible for their own bedding and toiletries. They should also bring swimsuits, towels, sunscreen, bug spray and warm clothing for cooler times.



Program Options

Weeklong/Half Week Overnight: Group homes, schools, families, long term care facilities, and organizations: Relax in the peacefulness of Bauneg Beg Lake in one of our rustic cabins for three or five days, Monday through Friday. Make new friends, enjoy swimming, boating, hiking, evening campfires and other recreational activities. Three meals and an evening snack provided daily.

Weekend Rentals/Special Events: Families, church groups, and organizations: Enjoy exclusive use of the facilities on the weekends for your special events and celebrations such as meetings, team building activities, birthdays, and family reunions. The facility can host over 100 people for day events and has up to 50 beds available for overnight use. Special accommodations can be made for Waban staff to provide Red Cross Certified Lifeguards or home cooked meals.

Day Use: Residential homes, schools, long term care and nursing facilities: Relax in the peacefulness of Bauneg Beg Lake for the day. Activities include pontoon boat rides, swimming, kayaking, picnics, and plenty of time to soak up some sun by the water.
